2024 GKS* Year-End Celebration

“Building a Bright Future with GKS Scholars”

- Over 170 participants attend the 2024 GKS Year-End Celebration, including GKS scholars, representatives from embassies in Seoul and universities.
- The event is a platform for recognizing academic excellence, showcasing student talent, and fostering global connections among GKS scholars.

The Ministry of Education (led by Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Education Lee Ju-Ho) and the NIIED, National Institute of International Education (President Han Sang-shin) will organize the 2024 GKS Night of Year-End Celebration at the National Institute of International Education on December 18, 2024.

The Global Korea Scholarship, GKS, is the Korean government's flagship scholarship program that invites international students to obtain a higher education degree in Korea. Since its launch in 1967, it has supported over 17,532 students from 160 countries around the world by 2024.

The GKS Night of Year-End Celebration is held annually to both promote GKS scholars' pride and provide an opportunity for interaction among scholars, universities, and other stakeholders. This year's event will be attended by 170 foreign scholars, as well as ambassadors and diplomats from 15 countries, and university officials. It will include an award ceremony to celebrate and encourage the scholars' academic achievements, a special performance by the scholars themselves, a dialogue with alumni, and a dinner.

First, students with outstanding academic achievements this year will be

honored, and merit awards will be presented to outstanding partner institutions, such as universities. In addition, NIIED will also award the winners of "Study in Korea Promotion Video (short-form videos) Contest," organized by NIIED to spread positive awareness about studying in Korea.

The event will be followed by a special K-pop performance given by the scholarship beneficiaries and a conversation with alumni who will share their experiences of studying abroad. It will conclude with a dinner where attendees can interact with each other.
